Join me in my struggle by praying to God for me . . . Rom 15:30

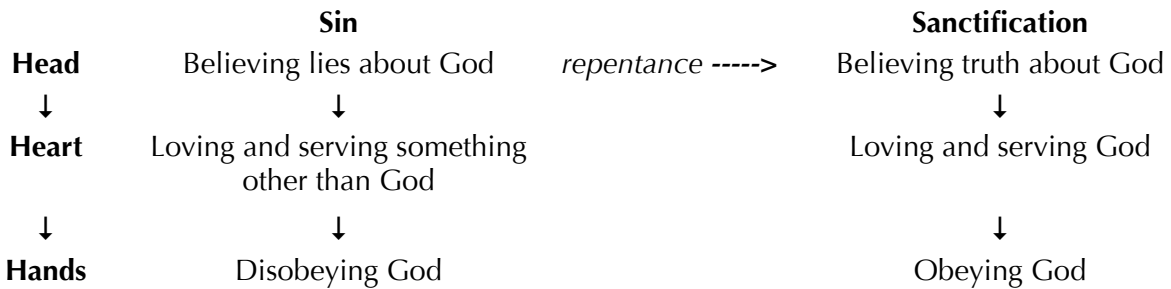
Pray for one another according to the needs you already identified.

Lies to Turn From . . . Truths to Turn To

God is Good—so we do not have to look elsewhere

Lie: God is holding out on me; the good life is found in things other than God and his will

Truth: God is always seeking my good; the good life is only found in God and his will

God is Great—so we do not have to be in control

Lie: God is not in control; I need to take control of my life in sinful ways

Truth: God is in control; I can trust him to take care of me

God is Gracious—so we do not have to prove ourselves

Lie: God accepts me based on my worthiness; I must prove my value to God and the world

Truth: God accepts me as I am, based on Christ's worthiness; I do not need to earn the approval of God or others

God is Glorious—so we do not have to fear others

Lie: Other people's honor and respect matter most; I seek to please and honor others

Truth: God alone his worthy of my honor and respect; I seek to please and honor God
